PAYMENT FOR NEGLIGENCE Nobody likes a personal injury lawyer until they need one. "When there is something dangerous that's seriously injuring or killing people, unless a business has a financial incentive to fix it, they won't," Glasheen says. "We make them pay, so they fix it. If no one speaks up, these entities won't correct the problem and others will get hurt."
